

Cleaner Air, Healthier City: The Impact of Delivery Mates in 2023

In 2023, Delivery Mates' commitment to sustainable deliveries using electric cargo bikes made a significant positive impact on London's environment and public health.

- Reduced CO2
 Emissions: By switching to electric vehicles, we prevented 102,520 kg of CO2 from entering the atmosphere, contributing to cleaner
- Lowered NOx
 Emissions: Our
 operations helped cut
 265,590 grams of
 harmful NOx gases,
 improving overall air
 quality.
- Minimized PM2.5
 Pollution: We successfully reduced
 3,654 grams of PM2.5 particulate matter, leading to a healthier environment for all.
- Reduced NHS Costs:
 Through cleaner air, our efforts are estimated to have saved the NHS an estimated £17,639.
